CLASSROOM NEWS

- In English we will be writing a story adaptation based on 'The Journey' text.
- We will also be learning new spelling patterns during our Read Write Inc. spelling sessions.
- We are focusing on column addition, subtraction and 2,4,8 times table in Maths.
- We are learning about Light and Shadows in Science. We will be exploring the link between light and darkness, observing reflections and investigating different factors that affect shadows.

- In Geography we will be learning about the Earth's structure.
