CLASSROOM NEWS

- This half term school value is: Friendship. We will be looking at aspects and qualities of friendship and how sacred they are.
- In Maths pupils will continue with the 2, 4, and 8 times table unit. The children will begin the 'Fractions' topic
- In English we will be reading 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. The children will have write an adventure story based on 'Journey' using the language of Berlie Doherty.
- In Science we will be learning about 'Plants and Reproduction.' We will explore the plant anatomy, and the lifecycle of flowering plants;
