YEAR 3



Prehistoric Art
We have been learning about prehistoric art, recreating the style of cave artists using charcoal and natural pigments. Pupils experimented with colour mixing, and creating large-scale artworks, enhancing both artistic skills and historical knowledge.

Bronze Age to Iron Age

This half term, the children have been learning all about Bronze Age to the Iron Age. We created a timeline and placed events in a chronological order. We looked at the process of smelting and we also studied artefacts to understand how human life changed during the Bronze and Iron Age. Amongst other learning we also identified the features of an Iron Age hill fort.
