This week is interfaith week. The children are learning about the theme of 'Stronger Together' and will be completing various activities.



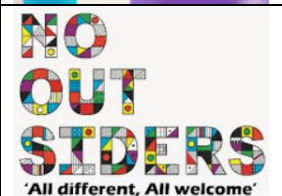
Our anti-bullying week starts tomorrow. This starts with the usual 'Odd Socks Day' – the brighter and wackier the better.
